Club offers annual Bicycle Expo

The Cascade Bicycle Club is holding its 12th annual Seattle International Bicycle Expo this weekend. The year's event will be held at a new location, Warren G. Magnuson Park in Seattle.

When: 9 a.m.-6 p.m. Saturday and 10 a.m.-4 p.m. Sunday.

Where: Warren G. Magnuson Park, 7400 Sand Point Way N.E., Seattle.



The 12th annual Seattle International Bicycle Expo on Saturday and Sunday will feature exhibitors, how-to lectures, book signings and presentations by cycling personalities.

Activities: More than 150 exhibitors with products and services related to cycling, how-to lectures, book signings and presentations by cycling personalities.

Presenters: The list includes Hunter Allen, coach for national and world cycling champions; Sally Edwards, who helped start triathlons; and Willie Weir, author of "Spokesongs" and a columnist for Adventure Cyclist magazine.

Other highlights: An exhibit by the Oregon Bicycle Constructors Association, bike fitting by Group Health, the 10th annual bicycle photo contest, an outdoor manufacturer's test ride area and a Kids' Bike Zone featuring a cyclocross clinic.

Admission: Tickets will be available, cash only, at the door. Adult tickets are \$8 for a single day or \$7 for Cascade Bicycle Club members. Two-day passes, something new this year, can be purchased for \$10. Children 15 and younger are admitted free.
